Pre-Apprenticeship Training Opportunities!

Do you live in public or transitional housing?

Are you keen to work in the **Building and Construction Industry**?

Are you ready to enrol in a **Pre Apprenticeship** course?

Course enrolment fees:

- Assistance with enrolment fees are available for eligible jobseekers via their job services provider.
- Financial assistance from the Public Tenant Employment Program (PTEP) may be available to eligible applicants.

Building and Construction Pre Apprenticeship (Certificate II) courses include: plumbing, carpentry, painting & decorating, electro technology and bricklaying.

PTEP assists pre-apprenticeship graduates into apprenticeships for the above trades. When you have completed your pre-apprenticeship you can be referred to suitable apprenticeship vacancies in your chosen trade as they arise.

To be eligible you must:

- Live in Public Housing or Transitional Housing
- Hold a concession or health care card



What you need to do:

- Contact your local Job Services Australia consultant or TAFE/Registered Training Organisation and apply to enroll in a Pre Apprenticeship.
- Once you have been accepted into the course you can then apply to have your fees paid by contacting PTEP on 1800 451 553 or email ptep@dhs.vic.gov.au and completing a Tenant Training Application Form.
